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Top Number Fun Warm-Up Suggestions

Children are given two sets of coins - one in the left pocket and one set in the right pocket. Are they equivalent in value or not? I.e. is it a Clap Snap?

Money Cards

This set of playing cards provide a powerful tool for reasoning and exploration of money. The imagery includes coins and notes up to the value of £50. Choose the pictures and values appropriate for your objectives.



1-20 Image Cards

This expanded set of image cards for the numbers from 1 to 20. The images include coins and enable children to relate money to other number pictures.

Small Steps

1: Recognising coins



The Sergeant stops all his soldiers marching when they reach his Snack Store. Pause the video at 2:09 and talk about all the different coins you can see on the screen. What is going on? What's happening in the story? What can we learn?



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2: Recognising notes



Farmer Pete is deliberately dropping money on the floor. Verse 1 features £1 coins. Pause the video at 44 seconds. The image shows 3 x £5 notes with Farmer Pete appearing on each note! Use as a starting point for exploring notes.


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3: Counting in coins



Farmer Pete is deliberately dropping coins on the floor. Can you recognise the coins he is using? Can you count in 2s and 10s to work out how much money there is on the floor?
(Use the first 2 verses)



The Sergeant stops all his soldiers marching when they reach his Snack Store. What coins might you use to pay for a banana? Pause the video at 2:09 and talk about all the different ways you can make up 12 pence. Can you count each option to check the value is 12p?
